From Pool A Vcustomer & TCS qualified for the semifinals whereas JWT & Amex Global got in to play against them. Due to official work, players of JWT had to leave for Mumbai and as such CSC got a chance to play the semifinals. CSC utilized this chance to maximum and defeated Vcustomer (top ranked team of Pool A) to enter the finals with a huge margin of 15 points. In the second semifinal Amex Global started with a bang and took a lead of 12 points in the first 5 minutes with the combination of Pranay & Edwin and were leading by 6 points at the half time. TCS gathered themselves during half time, worked out a strategy and played according to it. George stayed in front, Alen played as a feeder while Udipta took charge of all the rebounds. This combination did wonders and soon scores were level. Edwin & Rahul Bhatia again took Amex in front as Raghav Nayar checked George and did not allow him to score. Jagjit & Udipta came to the rescue of their team by scoring 3 & 4 points respectively enabling their team to win the match by 5 points.

#### **Final**

George & Jagjit enabled TCS to take a lead of 8 points but CSC came back to reduce the lead to just 4 points at half time. TCS suffered two big blows as initially Udipta and then George twisted their ankles. This enabled CSC to comeback in the match and took a lead of 2 points with just 3 minutes remaining for the final whistle. Limping George came back to play and CSC ensured that no scoring opportunity is provided to him as they kept 2 players to check him. This gave chance to Jagjit and he scored twice to take a lead of 1 point with just 50 seconds to go. A crucial foul by CSC gave 2 free shots to George and he converted one to increase the lead to 2 points. When CSC team was coming to equalize, referees blew the final whistle and all the players of TCS were on the floor with bench players hugging them.

Jagjit Singh of TCS was declared Man of the match for excellent display of technique to score baskets through layouts under pressure.
