Mr. Arijit Mukherjee of GE Capital who has scored 227 runs in 5 innings off 209 deliveries, was not out twice, had a strike rate of 108 % and batting average of 75.67 runs.

Mr. Vikas Gujral of Max New York Life who has scored 189 runs in 5 innings off 136 Deliveries had a strike rate of 139 % and batting average of 37.8 runs

Mr. Ashish Mishra of Flextronics Software Systems who has scored 168 runs in 3 innings & was not out twice off 109 Deliveries had a strike rate of 154 % and batting average of 168 runs

Mr. Hardeep Singh of E-funds who has scored 379 runs off 201 deliveries with strike rate of 188% and batting average of 76 runs. In all he bowled 16-0-98-4 with strike rate of 24.5 and economy rate of 6.12 runs per over.

Mr. Pankaj Ahuja of Vertex who scored 154 runs off 113 deliveries with strike rate of 136% and batting average of 30.8 runs. His bowling figures were 19.2-1-144-10 has a strike rate of 14.4 runs per wicket and economy rate of 7.45 runs per over and took 7 catches in the tournament.

Mr. Gaurav Bhatia of Max New York Life who scored 151 runs off 114 deliveries with strike rate of 132% and batting average of 151 runs. His bowling figures were 22-1-145-5 with strike rate of 29 runs per wicket and economy rate of 6.6 runs per over
