We at Eventus, take great pleasure in thanking all the 44 teams for having participated in the tournament. We believe that this tournament marks key watershed in enhancing the spirit of participation and cooperation. We are happy to see that the spirit of accommodation and cooperation prevailed all through the tournament. The informal atmosphere during the matches afforded teams with an opportunity to exchange views in a relaxed manner. Our sincere thanks and appreciation for all the teams for being a part of this tournament, which was **the biggest ever Corporate Cricket Tournament.** It's a great honour for Eventus to be associated with this historic game of gentleman. **We are deeply indebted to Reebok and Pepsi for their unparalleled support and look forward to a long-standing association.** We appreciate the kind gesture of all the participating teams for choosing to be a part of this tournament and look forward to many more tournaments and your association with it. At last, on behalf of Eventus we assure you that we will strive to meet all the requirements to best of our ability.

In total **87 matches** were played wherein **66 league** and **21 knock out** matches were played in the span of **20 days** with an average of more than **4 matches per day.** Total of **23,239 runs** were scored while **1,286 wickets** fell in **3,864.5 overs (23,189 Balls).** The average score in the tournament per inning of 25 overs was **150.32 runs** whereas **7.40 wickets** fell in an inning and average score per wicket came to **18.07 runs.**

A total of **2,164 boundaries** were scored resulting in **8,656 runs** while **1,236 runs** came from **206 sixes** hit by the batsmen. Teams gave away **2,837 runs** through **extras**, which were **12.21% off the total runs scored.** **10,510 runs** were scored by way of running between the wickets to complete the total **23,239 runs** scored in the tournament.

Above statistics clearly indicate the diligent hard work infused in by all the participants with lot of zeal, zest and enthusiasm shown towards the game. The batsmen scored at a thundering rate of more than **6 runs per over** while the bowlers did not lag behind by taking **7.40 wickets** in an inning.

Best Batsman

Contenders in the best batsman category were:

Mayur Bora of IBM-Daksh who scored **171 runs in 5 innings** and was not out once off **136 deliveries**, had a strike rate of **131%** and batting average of **42.75 runs**.

Prashant Ahlawat of EFUNDS who scored **156 runs in 7 innings** and was not out four times off **168 deliveries**, had a strike rate of **93%** and batting average of **52 runs**.

Pankaj Kalia of Xansa who had taken **12 wickets** conceding **146 runs in 21 overs** had a strike rate of **12.16 runs per wicket** and economy rate of **6.95 runs per over**.

The Best Bowler of the Tournament went to Nitin Sehgal of EFUNDS despite the fact that Ankit Bhatia had better strike rate and economy rate because Nitin had bowled exceptionally well in the knockout matches and was instrumental in enabling his side to reach the finals.
