Best Batsman for Cup

Contenders in the best batsman category for Eventus Cup were:

Jitender Chaudhary of Luminous Technologies, he scored 259 runs off 216 deliveries in 6 innings with batting average of 43.1 runs and strike rate of 119.9%.

Hardeep Singh of EFUNDS, he scored 249 runs in 190 balls and was not out once in 6 innings with batting average of 49.8 runs and strike rate of 131%.

Vishal Tyagi of ITC Limited, he scored 230 runs in 142 balls and not out once in 3 innings with batting average of 115 runs and strike rate of 161.9%.

Franklin Andrews of EXL Services, he scored 217 runs in 161 balls and not out twice in 4 innings with his batting average of 108.5 runs and strike rate of 134.7%.

Though batting averages of Vishal Tyagi & Franklin were more than 100 runs but their team lost early in the tournament and they did not play against tough teams. Best Batsman of the Cup was awarded to Hardeep Singh of EFUNDS as he was second highest run scorer of the tournament with his batting average & strike rate better than the 3rd contender and he also scored a century during quarterfinal match.

Best Bowler for Cup

Contenders in the best bowler for Cup were:

Jitender Chaudhary of Luminous Technologies, he bowled 32-1-178-16 giving away 11.12 runs per wicket, economy rate of 5.56 runs per over and had a strike rate of 12 deliveries per wkt.

Ranjeet Singh of Luminous Technologies, he bowled 28-0-188-12 giving away 15.66 runs per wicket, economy rate of 6.71 runs per over and had a strike rate of 14 deliveries per wkt.

Yogender Negi of OPTO Group, he bowled 9-0-47-8 giving away 5.87 runs per wicket, economy rate of 5.22 runs per over and had a strike rate of 6.75 deliveries per wkt.

Nitin Kaushal of Hutch, he bowled 15.5-0-83-8 giving away 10.37 runs per wicket, economy rate of 5.24 runs per over and had a strike rate of 11.87 deliveries per wkt.

Yoginder Negi had the best bowling average, economy rate & strike rate but was far behind when compared with regards to taking wickets. Best Bowler of the Cup went to Ranjeet Singh of Luminous Technologies as he was the second highest wicket taker in the tournament and bowled brilliantly in the finals to restrict strong team of EFUNDS.

Best Batsman for Plate

Contenders in the best batsman category for Plate were:

Manish Kumar of Delphi Automotives, he scored 206 runs in 166 balls and not out once in 5 innings with his batting average of 51.5 runs and strike rate of 124%.

Himanshu Sikka of Image Graphix, he scored 132 runs in 114 balls and not out once in 5 innings with his batting average of 33 runs and strike rate of 115.7%.

Ashwani Kapoor of Image Graphix, he scored 114 runs in 101 balls in 6 innings with his batting average of 19 runs and strike rate of 112.8%.

Manmohan Gusain of GENPACT, he scored 110 runs in 101 balls and not out once in 3 innings with his batting average of 55 runs and strike rate of 108.9%.

S. Karthickeyan of GENPACT, he bowled 28-2-116-15 giving away 7.73 runs per wicket, economy rate of 4.14 runs per over and had a strike rate of 11.2 deliveries per wkt.

Satyender Sharma of Cargo Alliance, he bowled 17-1-112-12 giving away 9.33 runs per wicket, economy rate of 6.58 runs per over and had a strike rate of 8.5 deliveries per wkt.

Amit Sareen of Delphi Automotives, he bowled 20-0-118-10 giving away 11.8 runs per wicket, economy rate of 5.9 runs per over and had a strike rate of 12 deliveries per wkt.
