Batting Department

Though some good knocks were played but the only century of the tournament was scored by Mr. Sriram of HSS-BPO. He scored exact 100 not out against Aviva Life Insurance and that too in only 50 deliveries.

Some of the individual outstanding performances witnessed in the tournament are as follows.

Best Batsman

Contenders in the best batsman category were:

Aashish Khurana of Touchtel who has scored 251 runs in 5 innings and was not out twice in 242 Balls had a strike rate of 104% and batting average of 84 runs

Shriram of HSS-BPO who has scored 152 in 3 innings and was not out once in 104 Balls had a strike rate of 146% and batting average of 76 runs and the only player to score a century.

Vikas Prashad of ICICI Bank who has scored 243 runs in 5 innings and was not out twice in 234 Balls had a strike rate of 103% and batting average of 81 runs

MAN OF THE TOURNAMENT
