On this day, for the first time in the history of cricket any country crossed 400 runs in an inning of One Day International and the team chased the target with one ball to spare. In all 872 runs were scored off 99.5 overs at the rate of 8.73 runs per over.

At the time when Australia was setting target for South Africa, a match better than that was played in 6th Reebok Cup between IAF (Officers) & Global Vantedge. In this match 432 runs were scored off 48.5 overs at the rate of 8.85 runs per over (0.12 runs per over better).
